DEDICATION OF THE MARIAN GROTTO: I wish to thank the people of the parish for embracing the dedication of the Marian Grotto in so many various ways. The Mass in Church, the rite of blessing and the Living Rosary were a great expression of our faith. In spite of there being so many people from outside the parish there was ample food for everyone. Bishop Kenney, other priests and a lot of those who came have expressed grateful sentiments about the occasion. I would like to encourage individuals or groups of people to spend time in prayer at the grotto. On Sundays the Balfour Road gate will remain open from Mass time in the morning till after the 6pm Mass for people who may wish to come and say the rosary at the grotto.

INSTALLATION OF CCTV CAMERAS: For the security of our church premises and the people who come over six CCTV Cameras have been installed manning the parking yard, the Balfour Road entrance, the grotto area, the Sawpit Road entrance, the passage way leading into hall and the church itself. Up to now £2,149 has been raised through various second collections and fund raisers for the project. This is about half of the total cost of the system. For this reason, we shall continue to collect for CCTV Cameras till the end of the year. Please be generous as we shall need to offset the cost of the project.
