NEWS! A new edition of the Lectionary will come into use in England and Wales on the First Sunday of Advent, 1st December, 2024.

Unfortunately, this means that the missals we have been using will no longer have the correct translation of the readings. The Sunday missalettes that we use will be updated. On the plus side, it provides all ministers of the Word, clergy and lay alike, with an opportunity to take stock and refresh our appreciation of the work entrusted to us. A (free!) refresher programme for ministers is being offered online in two sessions from **3.00-4.00 pm on Sunday, 13th and 20th October.** It is limited to 40 participants. The first session focuses on ministry and the Word and the second focuses on the Lectionary itself. The course is led by Fr Allen Morris, former Secretary to the Bishops' Conference Department for Christian Life and Worship. It would be useful for anyone who reads in church to take part.
