Today is Palm Sunday.

We remember how Jesus was first welcomed into Jerusalem as a King. We shall begin with a procession, and I invite all the children to take part with me in that. Don't forget to get a palm to wave.

Wednesday: The Chrism Mass. The Archbishop will celebrate the Chrism Mass at 11.30 am on Wednesday morning in St. Chad's Cathedral. It is the occasion when the Holy Oils are blessed, and also when priests renew their commitment of service to God and the Church.



Maundy Thursday: The Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.00 pm on Maundy Thursday evening is the end of Lent and the start of the Easter Triduum. At this Mass we celebrate the institution of the Sacraments of the Eucharist and the Priesthood.



Watching at the Altar of Repose. After the Mass we shall go to the Altar of Repose and keep watch with Jesus, remembering His Agony in the Garden and His acceptance of His Father's will.

Good Friday: On Good Friday there is no Mass, but at 3.00 pm, the hour at which our Lord died, there is a "Solemn Celebration" of the Passion of our Lord.



Holy Saturday: The Lord's Day of Rest in the tomb. In the evening at 8.00 pm we begin our Easter celebrations with the Easter Vigil, the greatest event in the Church's year.

Gift Aid Envelopes. If you gift aid your weekly offerings in the collection (thank you), please collect your new box of envelopes from the back of church today.

Easter Duties. Because of the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Church says that all Catholics who have made their First Holy Communion should receive the Holy Eucharist sometime between Ash Wednesday and Pentecost Sunday. They should also take part in the Sacrament of Penance.

Eucharistic Ministers will be re-commissioned during the Mass of the Last Supper on Maundy Thursday.

The collection on Good Friday is for the Holy Places – i.e. for the upkeep of the sites in the Holy Land.

Traditionally the collection at the Easter Masses is your personal offering to your priest. There are envelopes at the back of church if you wish. Thank you.
