Christmas Concert.



This is a real treat in the lead-up to Christmas. On the evening of Saturday, 20th December (7.00-8.30 pm) the boys' choir from Worcester College will sing carols and Christmas songs in Our Lady's church, Cowley. Tickets, £15 per person, available next week from me after Mass.

First Friday. This Friday is the First Friday of the month. Novena Prayers to the Sacred Heart will be said before Mass on Thursday evening.

Advent. Today we enter into the Church's new year. The Sunday Mass Lectionary Cycle is Year A, and the Weekday Cycle when we get back to Ordinary Time will be Year 2. If you use the Daily Office of the Church, we start at Sunday, Week 1 of Advent today.

The Advent Wreath. As a sign of our preparation for Christmas we have our wreath. It has three purple candles, reminding us that we need to turn away from wrong and turn to Jesus. It also has a rose-coloured candle, representing the joy of this season, and a white candle, the "Christ Candle" which will be lit at Christmas.



The Christmas Tree. As you can see, we have a Christmas tree on the sanctuary area of the church. Our tree is not just a decoration. My idea is that we use it to put prayers on as we prepare to welcome Jesus at Christmas.

I invite you to decorate the tree with stars and for every star you hang you can also write a prayer for someone who you think needs to have some hope, peace, joy or love in their lives this Christmas.

Poor Parishes Fund. There will be a second collection at Masses next Sunday to support the Poor Parishes of the Diocese. The Poor Parishes Fund was put in place to help those smaller parishes where they experience difficulty in paying their day-to-day bills.

Advent Walk With Me Booklets. Advent begins next Sunday, and to help us to enter into this time of grace there are *Walk With Me* booklets on the church benches. There are also Advent calendars available in the porch.

My Day By Day Booklets for Advent are also available at the back of the church, price £1. These give us the readings at Mass every day during Advent. Please leave your money in the basket where you find the booklets.
